Applicants with a qualification equivalent to an Australian Bachelor degree in any field may qualify. On completion of the PQP program, students qualify to get into the 2 year Masters of Social Work (Qualifying) at ECU.



Upon completion of PQP (Social Work) at ECC, students need to meet extra English requirement to enter Master of Social Work (Qualifying). In accordance with the requirements of the Australian Association of Social Workers (AASW), international applicants for this accredited course are required to provide an IELTS Academic with an overall minimum score of 7.0 (no individual band less than 7.0). Internationally schooled applicants may also be required to meet this requirement.

Master of Social Work (Qualifying)

Social workers champion social justice, equality and human rights. They stand alongside individuals and communities to improve society's overall well-being, especially for the most vulnerable populations.

In this course, taught by highly qualified staff with practice experience, you'll develop the knowledge and skills to pursue a career as a professional social work practitioner, able to work in Australia and overseas. It includes 1000 hours of supervised fieldwork placements to hone your craft.

Professional internship

In each year of the program, students undertake compulsory professional practice comprising 500 hours over 13 weeks (totalling 1000 hours for the entire degree). The field education units are SWK6440 and SWK6450.
